If you failed the 2<sup>nd</sup> 9 weeks of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester, you are ineligible to show any projects in the CCISD FFA Livestock Show. Therefore, you must remove your animal(s) from the barn by Wednesday, January 15, 2020. If you would like your animal processed, we will be glad to assist in transporting it to *Goings Custom Slaughter* in Baytown. If you chose to send your animal to one of the processors, you are responsible for all processing fees. Another option is to send your animal to the local public livestock auction. Arrangements must be made in a timely manner with your respective agricultural science teacher. You will receive the current market price at the time of sale. If not removed by Wednesday, January 15, 2020, the project will be sold at the nearest public livestock auction. Students will be charged a \$100.00 hauling fee if arrangements are not made to remove the animal before Wednesday, January 15, 2020. Thank you for your immediate cooperation. Congratulations on your successful participation in the 2020 Show and Auction! As a participant, there are a few items of business that must be completed in order to finalize your sale payment.

Under the direction of your respective agriscience teacher and parent/guardian, you must complete a handwritten thank you letter to your buyer. After writing the letter, your agriscience teacher must proof it before it is sealed in an envelope. If you sold your animal or project through the auction, you are required to personally deliver the thank you letter and auction picture to your buyer. If you have any add-ons, you must write a thank you letter to that person or company as well. You have the option of either mailing the thank you letter for the add-on or delivering it in person. Your agriscience teacher will supply you with the name, address and phone number of your buyers and or add-on donors. If you sold broilers, turkeys or rabbits and they were to be processed and delivered, you are responsible for processing and delivering items along with the thank you letter and picture.

Please fill out the attached Student Completion Form, and have your buyer sign, indicating that they received their thank you letter and other necessary items. Next, you will need to fill out the top portion only of the Student Payout Form. Leave the bottom portion and amount blank for your teacher to fill in. Your payment will be processed when the above completed items are returned, and you have appropriately cleaned your animal pen/area at the barn, and you are clear of any fees owed to your FFA Chapter.

All items need to be completed prior to March 6, 2020. Your payment will be mailed to the address submitted.

## General Instructions

Section references are to the Internal Revenue Code unless otherwise noted.

### Purpose of Form

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) to report, for example, income paid to you, real estate transactions, mortgage interest you paid, acquisition or abandonment of secured property, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN to the person requesting it (the requester) and, when applicable, to:

1. Certify that the TIN you are giving is correct (or you are waiting for a number to be issued),
2. Certify that you are not subject to backup withholding, or
3. Claim exemption from backup withholding if you are a U.S. exempt payee. If applicable, you are also certifying that as a U.S. person, your allocable share of any partnership income from a U.S. trade or business is not subject to the withholding tax on foreign partners' share of effectively connected income.

**Note.** If a requester gives you a form other than Form W-9 to request your TIN, you must use the requester's form if it is substantially similar to this Form W-9.

**Definition of a U.S. person.** For federal tax purposes, you are considered a U.S. person if you are:

- An individual who is a U.S. citizen or U.S. resident alien,
- A partnership, corporation, company, or association created or organized in the United States or under the laws of the United States,
- An estate (other than a foreign estate), or
- A domestic trust (as defined in Regulations section 301.7701-7).

**Special rules for partnerships.** Partnerships that conduct a trade or business in the United States are generally required to pay a withholding tax on any foreign partners' share of income from such business. Further, in certain cases where a Form W-9 has not been received, a partnership is required to presume that a partner is a foreign person, and pay the withholding tax. Therefore, if you are a U.S. person that is a partner in a partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States, provide Form W-9 to the partnership to establish your U.S. status and avoid withholding on your share of partnership income.

The person who gives Form W-9 to the partnership for purposes of establishing its U.S. status and avoiding withholding on its allocable share of net income from the partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States is in the following cases:

- The U.S. owner of a disregarded entity and not the entity,
