All money is due September 5, 2019. Please provide a cashier's check or cash for the purchase of your project. See your Agriscience instructor for details. Read the following information carefully because there have been some changes. The \$20 entry fee has been included in the total.

Please Note: Whether you are paying in cash or with a cashier's check, we need for the cost of the animal to be separated from the cost of pen rent. (Ex: Steer = one cashier's check for \$1970.00 for the animal/entry and one cashier's check for \$200.00 for pen rent)

Broilers

Cost: \$2.00/bird, must purchase 25

Rabbits

Cost: You must purchase your own rabbits (cost will vary depending on how much you want to spend)

Breed: **Californians**

Entry Fee: \$20.00 for the CCISD Livestock Show and Auction Entry Fee

Suggested Breeding Dates: Between October 19 - October 26, 2019

Tattoo Date: January 6, 2020 from 3-5 pm in the CSHS Ag Shop (tattoo all of your babies)

Pens: Animals must be kept at home.

Total: \$20.00 (Entry Fee)

For each project, the student is responsible for securing feed and ensuring the animal is cared for. Eligibility check will be completed for the 2nd Nine Weeks grading period, January 14, 2020 (the "No pass, No play" rule is in effect). If an ineligible student has a project in the barn, the animal will have to be removed from the barn by January 15, before the start of the 2020 CCISD Livestock Show and Auction. You must be enrolled in one agriscience course to be eligible to exhibit a project.

Purchase of a livestock project(s) is not required of a student to be enrolled in an agricultural course or to participate in the CCISD show and auction. Students may also enter Ag. Mechanics, Floriculture, Horticulture, Visual Arts and Food Science projects to be a participant of the show and auction. Each exhibitor must be a paid FFA member in good standing with their respective chapter.

In addition to the payment of the project, students need to turn in an entry form, a W-9 with student information, a signed show rule agreement, a signed animal health care guidelines, and a signed barn rule agreement (if the project is kept in the barn) to their ag science instructor prior to selection.

Please note that if you plan to participate in the CCISD Livestock Auction, you will need to have official dress in order to Auction. Please see your Ag. teacher for details.
