The purpose of the FFA Booster Club Scholarship is to encourage students to further their education, participate in Ag Science/FFA activities and to show leadership and community involvement.

To be eligible for a Clear Springs FFA Booster Club scholarship, the student must meet the following requirements:

- 1) Be a graduating senior who is entering one of the following: a) College, b) Junior College, c) vocational/technical school.
- 2) Be a member in good standing as defined by the local FFA chapter of Clear Springs for at least the current (senior) year and one other previous year. (For Transfer Students: previous year membership can be in another school district)
- 3) Take a minimum of 2 semesters of Agricultural Science classes.
- 4) Have an average 3.0 GPA in the minimum 2 Agricultural Science classes.
- 5) Have an overall average GPA of 2.5 through the fall semester of the senior year.
- 6) Provide official school transcript with the application in a sealed envelope.
- 7) Participated in a minimum of three FFA activities per year. Ex. Community Service, Horticulture, Judging Teams, Leadership Teams, Shows, Conferences.
- 8) Have a project in the CCISD Livestock Show, County or Major show in one of the two years required in #2.
- 9) Provide proof of enrollment of a minimum of 6 hours in higher education to the Booster Club Treasurer before Dec 31st of the award year to receive payment of scholarship or forfeit the scholarship.
- 10) Applications will be scored and weighted.

The scholarship award is non-transferable and only one scholarship award per student is given.
