- -2 Waterers (pay attention to size)
- -Feeders
- -Bedding (shavings, flakes, etc.)
- -Box Fan
- -Heat lamps
- -Tarps
- -Scale
- -Boxes to start young
- -Cleaning supplies
- -Buckets
- -Feed bins
- -Extension Cords
- -Zip ties
- -Feed; Ex: Purina Honor Show Poultry Feed
- -When moving poultry into the barn, it is best to slowly allow them to have space as they grow. Keep them confined.
- -Pens are cleaned out every week to week and a half.
- -It is important to monitor wing bands as your broiler/turkey grow. Rotate/expand them regularly.
- -You will have to cull and take birds to the processor.
- -Shavings are dumped into the <u>DUMPSTER</u>, not water drains.
- -Students can spend anywhere from 1 hour to 4 hours cleaning out pens, supplies, and getting their birds to move and walk around.
