

Recommended supplies for a new Pig!

- Lindner's Oat Groats
- Shavings (mini flake, throughbed, and champions)
- Safeguard dewormer
- Vittles vaults containers or any airtight containers
- Feed troughs
- Pig whips (weaver livestock for example)
- Rice Root Brush or any livestock brush
- Pig oil (champions choice, hog fathers, pro charge, and purple oil.)
- Corona ointment
- Shampoo (clear choice, weavers medicated, or mane and tail)
- Conditioner (sudden impact spray and mane and tail)
- Buckets
- Pooper scooper
- Fans (box fan or industrial)
- Heat lamps
- Zip ties
- Fly traps
- Bronco fly spray (optional but the flies get bad sometimes)
- Lindner's 611 (starter feed)
- Zip ties
- Extension cords
- Storage or feed

-When moving any pig into the barn, the pig needs to be washed immediately. Pens should be bleached and rinsed before moving your pig in.

-**Safeguard** helps with Diarrhea and other illnesses.

-If your pig has diarrhea actively, use **Specto-guard** immediately.

-If you have a sick pig, call a vet.

-Shavings are changed about every week to week and a half. Always change when wet.

-Hallways and walkways near your pen or throughout the barn need to be swept regularly.

-Students can spend anywhere from 1 hour to several hours working, cleaning, and feeding their pigs a day.
